Gus G. Coulter was born August 15, 1861, in Marshall County, Kentucky. He was the son of C. C. and Belle (Archer) Coulter.

Gus Coulter was reared on a farm and was educated in Marshall County. In 1880 he became the deputy county clerk of Graves county by appointment. He was elected county commissioner and then county clerk. In 1885 he became chief clerk of the State Board of Equalization.

A Democrat, he was elected state Auditor in 1900 and his official record has placed him among the most capable state officials to serve the Commonwealth.
