ROBERT L. GREENE

1916 - 1919

Robert L. Greene was born December 3, 1855, in Warsaw, Gallatin County. He was the son of George and Jane Diltz Greene. When he was three years of age his parents moved to Bracken County, Kentucky. He attended the public schools and obtained his preliminary education and then entered Augusta College.

In 1873, he became deputy clerk of the circuit clerk of Pendleton County and later filled the same office in Kenton County. In January 1884, he became deputy clerk of the court of appeals, a position he held until January 1904. In 1897, he ran for that office and was defeated by a narrow margin of five votes.

He ran for the state Auditor's office in 1916 and was elected to that position.

He was interested in public issues for many years and gave his support to the Democratic party.

Robert L. Greene and Sue Boude were married in 1882 and of this union there was one son, Lewis Brent.
